

What have we done so far?



1. We represented a client before the Constitutional Court and before the European Court of Human Rights – we filed the complaint, presented a statement on the government opinion, and after the complaint was rejected, we filed an application to the Grand Chamber of the ECHR, which was granted.
2. We had a legal analysis of foreign legislations concerning home births carried out by a team of experts from Oxford Pro Bono Publico, which we used in our application to the Grand Chamber.
3. We asked Czech women to share stories of their experience from Czech hospitals in order to disprove the ideal image described to the European Court of Human Rights by the government of the Czech Republic. We sent about sixty sworn statements to the Court, and so that they wouldn't sink, Zuzana Candigliota, a lawyer of the League of Human Rights, used them as a basis for her article "Conditions in Czech hospitals – unchanged since 1950s".
